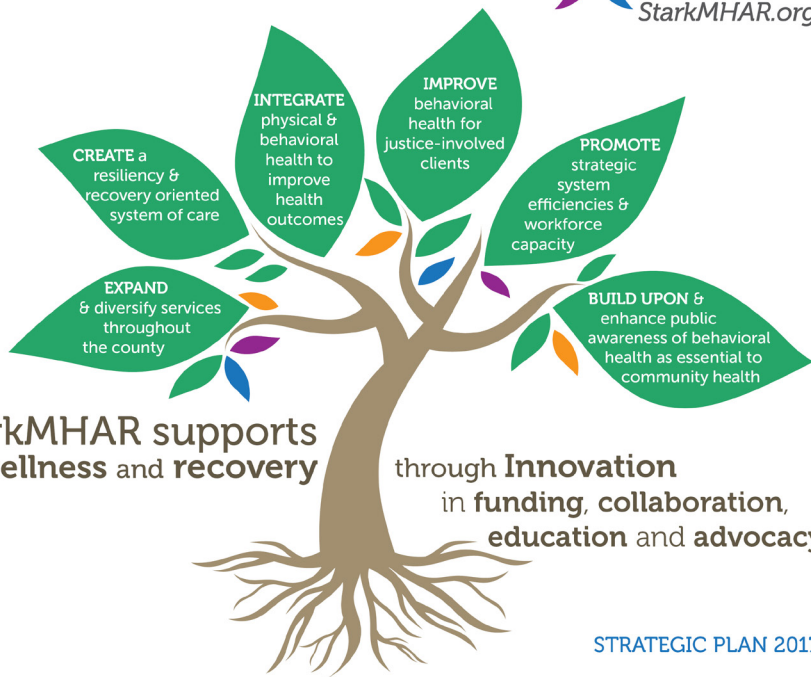

StarkMHAR also oversees that the following services are available to anyone in Stark County in need:

- Crisis Hotline
- Crisis Intervention
- Sub-acute detoxification services for alcohol, benzodiazepines and opiates
- Screening and assessment for access to the state hospital
- Forensic services
- Prevention and education

Ability to Pay Guidelines Stark County residents can access behavioral health services regardless of their ability to pay through the Stark County Mental Health & Addiction Recovery (StarkMHAR) Care Network. StarkMHAR funded service providers accept various insurance programs, Medicare and Medicaid. Stark residents that are not covered by one of those options can receive services. Their ability to pay for those services will be determined by their income and could be fully subsidized by StarkMHAR.

...in need of Naloxone.

Opiate overdose kits containing Naloxone are now available in Stark County. Naloxone is an intranasal spray medication that can reverse an overdose caused by an opioid drug (heroin or prescription pain medications). Get a kit and be prepared to save a life.
