## Drug Take Back Day is Saturday

Several area organizations will partner to sponsor Drug Take Back Day from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday. Sixteen locations throughout the county will be staffed with officers and volunteers collecting expired, unwanted and unused medications for safe disposal.

Prescriptions and over-the-counter medications will be accepted. The program is completely anonymous and no questions will be asked. No identification is needed.

The collection is sponsored by Stark County Mental Health & Addiction Recovery, the Stark County Sheriff's Office, Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Solid Waste Management District, Drug Free Stark County and the Opiate Task Force of Stark County, in cooperation with the Stark County Police Chiefs' Association.
