Job Posting: School Based CPST Provider / Prevention Specialist

CommQuest currently has an opening for a **Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment (CPST) Provider / Prevention Specialist** for our **School Based Team** to deliver services in assigned school(s) for the upcoming 2019-2020 school year. The **CPST Provider / Prevention Specialist** will be a split position with both CPST services, as well as Prevention services. CPST services include a focus on recovery and resiliency principles and prevention services include services that focus on prevention theories as they empower individuals to integrate, function, and succeed in their communities (homes, schools, work, and neighborhood).

Job Duties include:

- Provide mental health and/or AoD interventions including individualized life skills development, symptom monitoring, crisis management, ongoing assessment of needs, and client advocacy.
- Implementation of evidence based curriculum programs in groups including service learning and alternate learning activities.
- Strengthen involvement in community initiatives.
- Facilitation and development of daily living skills.
- Provide crisis intervention, as needed.
- Build strong relationships and relationship building skills with diverse populations.
- Promote positive parenting and family engagement.
- Develop and coordinate Individualized Service Plans (ISP).
- Focus on recovery and resiliency principles.
- Practice advocacy and outreach on behalf of clients.
- Work effectively in schools, homes, and community.
- All other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Psychology, or related field is required.
- Minimum of one or more years of experience in the provision of CPST services is highly desired.
- Previous work experience in working with students in a school setting (Pre-K through 12th) is highly preferred.
- Qualified staff will be expected to have or obtain the Qualified Mental Health Specialist (QMHS) credential and Chemical Dependency Counseling Assistant (CDCA) certification, if assigned to a high school setting.
- Qualified staff will be expected to become a registered applicant for the Ohio Certified Prevention Specialist (OCPS I,II) credential within 3 months of employment and obtain OCPS credentialing within 3 years of hire.

- Position requires routine evening hours and a willingness to allow some flexibility in scheduling a caseload.
- Must have a valid Driver's License, proof of auto insurance, a driving record in accordance with agency standards, and requires use of personal vehicle.

School Based Mental Health Assignment Terms:

- SBMH Providers will be assigned to one or more K-12 school and are expected to work a 40-hour work week.
- **Must** meet a total of 1,560 work hours during the annual contract period (school year).
- Work schedule must meet the position requirement and match the assigned school(s) calendars (required student-days plus staff days and preparation) for a total of 40 weeks, with scheduled school breaks (summer, holiday, and spring), and no additional earned PTO (paid-time off).
- In addition, Providers are required to work prior to the beginning of the school year, and after the completion of the school year until a total of 1,560 work hours and productivity targets are met.
- Each SBMH provider must attain a **minimum** of 680 billable units per school year, including consultation, outreach, treatment, or other billable assigned services.

School Based Mental Health Full Time Benefits:

- Health, Dental, Vision insurance, etc. – eligible first of the month following start date
- Ten paid holidays on an annual basis
- Mental health days and sick time
- **PAID** summers off (once SBMH contract terms have been met)!!!!!!
