Seeking a Peer Support Specialist to provide peer support activities in Stark County, Ohio. This position is a role model to peers, exhibiting competency in personal recovery and the use of coping skills, serving as an advocate, and providing information about peer support in outpatient and inpatient settings. This person performs a wide range of tasks to help peers regain independence within the community and ownership over their own recovery process by using a variety of techniques. Peer Support Specialists provide guidance, hope, and support toward recovery through personal experience and growth and on a reciprocal basis.

Minimum requirements include a high school diploma, completed state peer support training or willingness to complete such training, and lived experience in mental illness or substance use. Must be able to cope with mental and emotional stress related to work with persons who are experiencing mental health concerns and crises. Must have and maintain excellent driving record.

Benefits options include health insurance, life insurance, paid time off, and more. Qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability or protected veteran status.
