Candidates must have an active Ohio RN license, valid NPI number, and Ohio Medicaid number and at least two years of RN-level nursing experience and with documenting in electronic health records. Due to the teamwork required, candidates must be able to work effectively and collaboratively as a team, interacting with clients, external care providers and stakeholders, clinicians, and others in a diverse workforce while being able to exercise balanced judgement in evaluating situations and making decisions, and handling difficult and confrontational situations in a calm, consistent, and equitable manner. An acceptable driving record with a willingness to transport clients is needed as well. Additionally, candidates must be willing to work evenings, weekends, and holidays as needed to meet program needs and participate in on-call rotation.
