Qualified candidates will have their Master’s degree along with LSW or LPC licensure, must be eligible for an NPI number and an Ohio Medicaid number, have and maintain an excellent driving record, and 2 years’ experience working in the behavioral healthcare field. Prefer someone with LISW or LPCC licensure, work experience in community behavioral health or crisis intervention setting, and someone with experience in motivational interviewing, crisis intervention, and trauma informed care.
