- Engaging with parents/guardians of persons served when appropriate and required
- Assisting with key social determinants of health needs, including food, income, and housing
- Completing follow-up calls and care to assess progress, barriers, and goals to promote wellness and recovery

Qualified candidates must be licensed as an LPCC, LISW, LIMFT, or Psychologist. Candidates must also have a NPI number, an Ohio Medicaid number, and a CAQH account created. Previous experience in child and adolescent behavioral health or other medical setting is preferred.
