Opportunity Available: Behavioral Health Respite Specialist – Part Time

Job Qualifications Include: Applicants must be at least 21 years of age with a high school diploma or GED, have at least one year experience working with children and adolescents, preferably with emotional/behavioral challenges. Applicants must be able to demonstrate understanding and consideration for the cultural differences among the children and families served by Pathway Caring for Children, while approaching their work with cultural humility. Applicant must possess a valid driver's license, a safe driving record, meet the auto insurance coverage requirements, and a car that is safely maintained and have the willingness to travel to locations served by Pathway.

Description of Position Include: The Behavioral Health Respite Specialist is responsible for utilizing a trauma-competent framework in providing short-term, temporary community-based relief to the primary caregiver(s) of an OhioRISE plan enrolled child or youth, in order to support and preserve the primary caregiving relationship. The BH Respite Specialist will work with individuals and families to provide person-centered care and treatment services. This position will start part-time (up to 30 hours a week) and could move to full-time as the caseload increases. Primary responsibilities include:

- Assistance with activities of daily living, transportation and supports in home and community-based settings
- Support opportunities that increase problem-solving skills to improve self-regulation, socialization, and maximize an individual's ability to participate in community activities independently or with natural supports.
- Provide recreation and leisure including supports identified in the person-centered individual service plan as being therapeutic in nature, and/or as being necessary to assist the individual in developing and/or maintaining social and familial relationships.
- Implement behavioral health treatment by providing services based off the individual's mental health needs including, but not limited to: skills development, problem solving, conflict resolution, emotions/behavior management, developing positive coping mechanisms, and managing mental health and behavioral symptoms.
- Attend individual/group supervision and required meetings/trainings
- Maintain accurate records of service delivery and timely completion of paperwork.
