Opportunity Available: Early Childhood Prevention Specialist/Case Manager– Full Time

Job Qualifications Include: The successful applicant for this position shall have minimum high school diploma with bachelor's degree preferred and have at least 6 months experience working with young children; experience in working with groups and ability to work well with many different types of people; possess a valid driver's license, a good driving record, the ability to drive to homes and other community locations, and automotive liability insurance. This person must meet the background screening as defined in OAC code 5101:2-5-09. Demonstrates consideration, understanding and humility for the diversity of the children and families served by Pathway.

Description of Position Include: Early Childhood Prevention Specialist/Case Manager uses a Trauma Competent approach that promotes resiliency while providing consultation and early intervention support to early childhood age children and childcare staff in the classroom setting as well as and families and behavioral health case management to assigned clients. Prevention will be delivered through evidenced based programming in group settings. Specialist/CM collaborates with schools, community organizations, individuals and families to provide information and awareness. Specialist/CM plans and implements evidenced based programs to a targeted demographic. Various responsibilities include: Servicing clients at the Fairless Local, Osnauburg Local East Canton, and Heritage Christian school systems, all located central to the Canton Ohio area; Initial and ongoing assessment of needs; Assisting with accessing natural support systems in the community; Link to formal services/systems, advocacy and outreach; Coordinate and/or assist in crisis management and stabilization as needed; Educate and train specific to the individual's assessed needs, abilities and readiness to learn; Planning and facilitate prevention programming through evidenced based curriculum; Facilitate skills development groups and activities.
